2021 FAI F5J European Championship for Electric Powered Thermal Duration Gliders, seniors and juniors will be organised by the Hungarian Association of Modellers, Szeged Modelling Association and Municipality Szatymaz from 22-28 August 2021, at Szatymaz, Hungary.

The organizers will make final decision on the organization of the EC latest on 05th June 2021 based on the Covid-19 pandemic situation and preliminary entry information's received.

1. Competition rules

Class F5J seniors and juniors

European Championship will be run according to:

- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 - CIAM General Rules
- FAI Sporting Code Section 4, Aeromodelling Volume F5 Radio Control Electric Powered Model Aircraft, latest Edition
- FAI Code of Ethics
- FAI anti-doping regulations

Valid FAI sporting licenses will be mandatory for competitors and team managers.

Only licenses which are registered on the FAI database are valid.

2. Official languages

The official languages are English and Hungarian.

3. Location

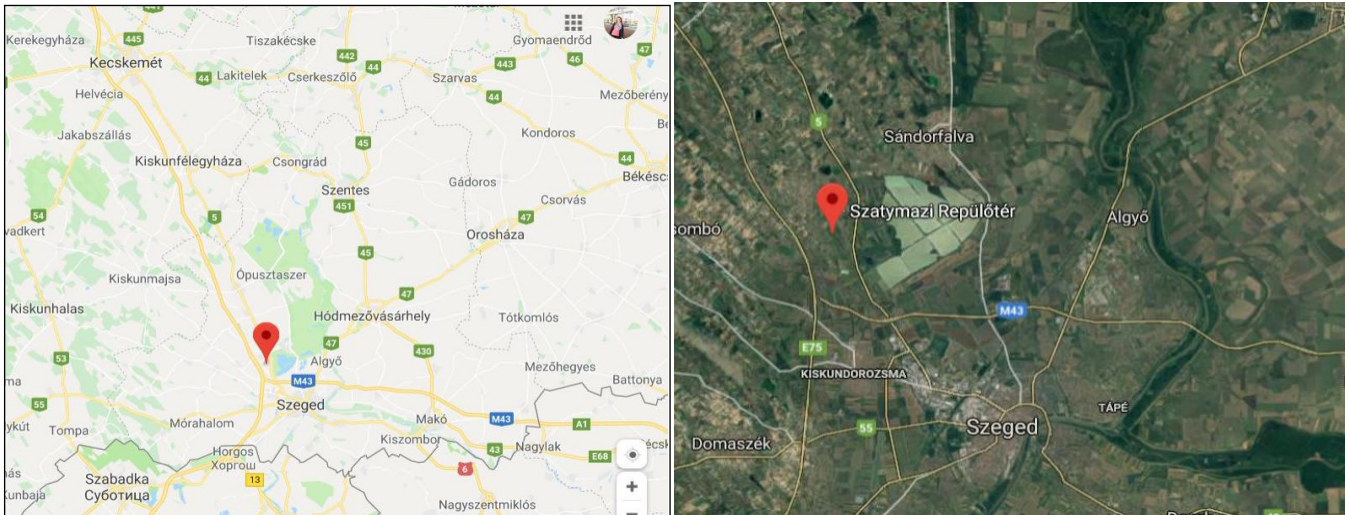
Airport near Szatymaz – 17 km North of Szeged,

6. National teams and competitors

Each team may consist of:

- Team manager (for both teams or separated for senior and junior team)
- 3 senior competitors, or 4 competitors if at least one is female
- 3 junior competitors, or 4 competitors if at least one is female
(**age limit 18 years in 2020**)
- junior reigning champion – as individual if he is not a member of national team
- senior reigning champion – as individual if he is not a member of national team
- official helpers and supporters

Team-managers are requested to bring the following items to registration:

- Copy of banking payment receipts.
- One national flag (approx. 1 m x 1.5 m).
- CD or USB with the national anthem.
- Official entry form with stamp and sign of NAC
- Model Aircraft Specifications.

7. Classifications and awards

Individual classification

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third for juniors and seniors.

In order to award the title of Junior European Champion, junior competitors from at least four nations must participate in the class.

For the additional female senior classification, FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third.

The best female earns the title of senior Female European Champion if females from at least four different nations participate in that class.

For the additional female junior classification, FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed first, second and third.

The best female earns the title of junior Female European Champion if females from at least four different nations participate in that class

Team classification

For the team ranking the best three results of the team will be considered.

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to each members and the team manager of the teams placed first, second and third.

The daily flying schedule will begin at **09.00** and will continue through the various rounds till **19.00**. The organiser reserves the right to change the daily schedule if necessary.

9. Frequencies

According to the rules, only 2.4 GHz spread spectrum radio control systems are allowed (output power up to 100 mW according to EN 300 328 Standard).

Request for other frequencies 35MHz, 40MHz, if needed, must be sent to organizers who will provide permit for use, if it is possible.

10. Weather

Continental climate exists without big contrasts.
Daily temperature in August is between 15–35 C degrees.
Light wind, variable direction.
Sunrise: 05.50 – Sunset: 19:30.

11. Entry fees

250 EUR for team manager and team manager assistant
250 EUR per adult competitor
100 EUR per woman competitor
100 EUR per junior competitor
50 EUR per helper, supporter
Banquet: 40 EUR per senior competitors, TM, helpers, guests
25 EUR for juniors

12. Deadlines

1. Intent to enter team with number of senior and junior (male/female) competitors (Preliminary Entry Form): 30th May 2021.
2. Official entry (Final Entry Form) including competitors names: 30th June 2021.
3. Receipt of all entry fees: 10th July 2021.

Entry fees submitted after 10th July 2021 +10 % penalty.

Any submitted after 30th July 2021 + 20 % penalty.

Entry fees will not be accepted on arrival.

17. Anti-doping

If a competitor has to take, by a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Prohibited list: www.wada-ama.org

Quotation from the FAI anti-doping regulations: "If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA prohibited list, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, national level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control".

18. Insurance

The organizer will provide a limited third-party liability insurance covering all competitors for model accidents involving injury to others and damage to property.

It is recommended that individual health and travel insurance is purchased before travelling.

For EU citizens, health care is covered under Social Health Care by presentation of an EU 11 form, available in the country of residence.
